- The book will be published by **PETER LANG PUBLISHING** (Switzerland-Germany) (<https://www.peterlang.com/>).
- Each chapter of the book, including bibliography, is limited with in minimum 20,000 spaceless characters - maximum 30,000 spaceless characters
- The title of your chapter should reflect the book entitled: “Smaller World, Bigger Issues: Growth, Unemployment, Inequality, and Poverty”.
- Your study should be divided into clearly defined and numbered sections, including Introduction, Conclusion and References. For the other sections such as Literature review, Methodology etc., the authors are free to arrange their sections. Any subsection should be given a brief heading and extended up to second degree.
- Use as few tables and figures as possible in the book section. The figures and pictures should be in black and white and the image quality should be high. Also the source should be mentioned.
- Full texts will be checked with ithenticate plagiarism software after proofreading process. The similarity rate should be equal to or less than 15%.
- Full text should be edited according to the format in the Template file (Page margins, Figures and Tables, References, etc.) and the number of pages should not exceed 12.
- The editing of the texts and harmonization of the language with the other chapters in the book by the translation company, editorship, refereeing, proofreading and printing will be performed.
- In case you participate in the book project, please email the title of the chapter, abstract (150-300 words), keywords (2-4) and running title (max 90 characters) in the word document before .....
- The book is planned to be published latest in September 2019. The **deadline** for the full texts is ......
- The chapters will have a maximum of three authors and each author will be included in only one chapter. Only one book per chapter will be given after the publication. The book is planned to be published as e-book. The book will be available worldwide as an e-book after the copyright transfer to the publisher.
